



A REGULAR MEETING WAS HELD BY THE EAST DEER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON THURSDAY 08, 2020 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OF EAST DEER TOWNSHIP, CREIGHTON, PA.

MR. TALIANI CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER

ROLL CALL

The secretary called the roll: Anthony Taliani-present; Rick Stoneburner- present; Edward Kissel- present; Joseph Novosat- present; John Nwranski- present

MINUTES

Mr. Stoneburner moved to dispend the reading of the minutes of the September 9, 2020 regular meeting as dually posted by the township Secretary. Mr. Kissel seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

CITIZENS COMMENTS

COMMUNICATIONS

Mr. Taliani advised that we received letter from Tarentum Borough on the raising of the water rates to East Deer. He advised that we have been waiting on these and they advised that they would be raising at 15%. most of it is at the 15%.. the highest point it is a 31% raise. But now that we have this, we would be able to start working on our 2021 Budget. He also asked Mr. Alexander to look over all of it.

Mr. Taliani advised that we received an email from Julian Hazlet that live on Bailies Run that he is working on his Eagle Scout project: My proposal is to construct trash receptacles to be sited at the bus stops from Murray Hill Road to Bailies Run Road along both sides of the highway. The receptacles will be made of Trex type lumber along the railroad side of the roadway with weighted bottoms and the receptacles on the sidewalk side will be made of welded steel and painted, this will allow for a reduction in the space needed as the sidewalks are narrow. These metal receptacles can either be weighted or strap mounted to a pole at the bus stops. The only responsibility of the Township of East Deer in this project would be the regular collection of the trash from the receptacles. This will provide benefit the community by reducing the trash blowing about. Mr. Taliani advised to the board that they should approve this for Julian in New Business.

Mr. Taliani advised that we also received an email from the RCTC that they have purchased property on top of Murrayhill. the have asked if we would like a virtual meeting to talk about the property. Mr. Taliani advised t Mr. Novosat to get with them since he has been in touch with them before.

BIDS

Mr. Taliani advised that we have to set on our refuse bids that we received last month that we tableted to this month. . Bid #1 from Vogel Disposal based on the specifications that we advertised. \$136,329 for 1 year ; \$277,488 for 2 year ; \$420,577 for 3 years and \$574,857 for 4 years accompanied by bid bond of \$57,485.70. Bid #2 is from Bankosh Sanitation LLC 287 County Road Slickville PA 15684, \$120,000 year 1; \$122,500 2nd year; \$125,000 3rd year

and \$128,000 4th year for a total of \$495,500 for the 4 year. . Mr. Taliani recommended that we award the 2021-2024 Refuse contract to Bankosh Sanitation LLC 287 County Road Slickville PA 15684. Mr. Taliani and Mrs. Carmen advised that they spoke with other municipality's about Bankosh and that they have received high remarks. Mr. Taliani asked the wish of the board. Mr. Nwanski moved to accept the 2021-2024 Refuse contract with Bankosh Sanitation. Mr. Novosat 2nd the motion. Motions passed unanimously.

Mr. Taliani advised that we also Recommendation Letter from Senate Engineering's to award the 2020 Demolitions to the lowest responsible bidder in the base bid amount of \$58,100.0 to Lutterman Excavation, LLC of 1813 SR. 1819 Greensburg Pa 15601. Mr. Taliani asked Mr. Herman if we are able to switch out house in the base bid for one or so of the alternates. Mr. Herman advised that we can do that. Mr. Kissel motioned to award the recommendation from Senate on the base bid to Lutterman Excavation, LLC of 1813 SR. 1819 Greensburg Pa 15601. in the amount of \$58100.00. Mr. Stoneburner 2nd the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Mr. Taliani and Mr. Herman will meet next week to go over the houses and proceed.

1) As you can see there is a lot of work being done on Freeport road the past few days, Found out last week that they were thinking of shutting the project down till next year. With the help from State Rep. Frank Dermody and his hoffice, hey got it back on the schedule to finish the concrete and pave at least up to ferry street this year. They were to go about 600 feet above Ferry street and stop and then finish up next year thru Tarentum.

2) You will see that we are paving Edna Alley starting today and we are doing this our self with the equipment that was purchased thru the joint purchase of the AVNCOG. Stop and take a look at it. it is a very tight alley. We will save about \$20K doing this ourselves.

3) You all know that there has been some issues on Days Run Road which is a State road. With the help from State Rep. Frank Demordy's office we have gotten with Penndot and they will be out by the end of the month to fix the Dip in the road that is towards the end of Days run in the township, they are also going to be painting some lines and cutting back some trees that are hanging low. I hope to get with them next week for an update.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Nwranski advised that the annual report was submitted by the end of September and that there is a free class being offered that he has registered for and that it would be a great idea for our highway supervisor to register. Mrs. Carmen advised that Mr. Bertolini is already sign up for the class.
