This will be used to correct the last two combination sewer/storm drains on Bellview Street and the rest of money will be used on the Crystal sliding and storm drain. We also have the Pa Small Water/ Sewer that is being used to work on the Water Meter Pit and the rest of that will be bided out soon. That will be close to 400K of work that will be done. Again, these are the last two grants that we thank Frank Dermody with getting.

This agreement should be In a form acceptable to the East Deer Township Solicitor. Mr. Nwranski motion to approve. Mr. Kissel 2nd the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
