OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Taliani advised that we have the Free Libraries from last month to discuss. Mr. Novosat advised that he talked to the director, and they are happy that we are going to participate. We have kicked around a few locations. We are thinking about by the memorial and the old Sheetz parking lot, facing Michaels Auto the very far part by the opening of the parking lot up Crawford. Mr. Novosat advised that Mr. Pitsch said something about at the park, Mr. Taliani said he is afraid that it would be vandalized there. He agrees that the location that Mr. Novosat has suggested is a good one, it will be under lights and more seen better. Mr. Nwanski motioned to have the little free library put at the location on Crawford Run Road and the corner of the grass by the memorial. Mr. Stoneburner seconded the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that it has been regularly moved and second, any questions or comment, all in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Taliani advised that the 2023 Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department Budget was passed and that it is given to each of the 3 municipalities that are members to approve at \$229,200 per municipality. Mr. Taliani asked the wish of the board on the 2023 budget for the Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department that was given to them in their packets. Mr. Nwanski motioned to approve the 2023 Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department. Mr. Kissel second the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that that is has been regularly moved and second to approve the 2023 Allegheny Valley Regional Police Departments Budget, any questions, or comments, all in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Taliani asked the wish of the board on the East Deer Township 2023 Budget with no increase in taxes the millage will remain the same at 4.9 mills. He advised that in the last ten years that there has been to decrease in taxes and no increases. Mr. Kissel motioned to approve the Preliminary 2023 East Deer Township Budget. Mr. Stoneburner 2nd the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that it has been regularly moved and second to approve the 2023 Preliminary East Deer Township Budget with a tax rate of 4.9 mills, any questions comments, all those in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Taliani advised that we have a request for reimbursement #1 from the GTRP for 85% \$16,504.00, total invoice amount of \$19,147.00 The difference between the two is the local match that we will pay. What is the wish of the board on reimbursement #1. Mr. Stoneburner motioned to approve reimbursement #1 from the GTRP. Mr. Nwanski seconded the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that is has been regularly moved and second to approve the request for reimbursement #1, any questions or comments, all those in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Taliani advised that we have a request for reinstatement #4 for the PA Small Water & Sewer program for a total invoice of \$45,662.40 with the amount of \$38,779.04 from the grant and the rest will be from our local match. Mr. Nwanski motioned to approve reimbursement #4 for the PA Small Water & Sewer program for \$38,779.04. Mr. Stoneburner second the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that is has been regularly moved and second to approve the request for reimbursement #4, any questions or comments, all those in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Taliani asked the wish of the board to advertise and sell the surplus Ford pick up truck, salt spreader and plow from the Public Works department once the new one is in service. Mr. Stoneburner motioned to advertise to sell the surplus Ford Pick up Truck, salt spreader and plow from the Public Works Department. Mr. Nwanski second the motion. Mr. Taliani advised that is has been regularly moved and second, any questions or comments, all those in favor say I. Motion passed unanimously.

BILLS

Mr. Taliani asked the wish of the board on the monthly bills presented by the Township Secretary. Mr. Novosat motioned to pay all bills presented by the Township Secretary. Mr. Kissel 2nd the motion. Mr. Taliani advised it has been regularly moved and seconded, any questions or comments, all in favor, say I. Motion passed unanimously.
