Mr. Taliani - Report on a couple of things, personally I think that 2023 was a big year for East Deer Township. First, we enacted a tax cut, our industrial sector is continuing to grow with the Brewery, Air Products has finished their 35-million-dollar renovation, Pitt Penn Recycling has expanded. We completed the following projects this year, Bailes Run Road Water line that was financed ourselves. Marion Street Water Line phase 1, we did a slide remediation on Crystal View Drive. New storm sewer on Crystal View Drive, Sewer line separation on Bellview Street, which are the last two lines in town that need to be separated. Grant street

Phase 2 Water line was completed so Grant Street is completed. We paved Oliver Street and Bellview Street. We paved those ourselves with the equipment of the joint with the COG. Saved taxpayers thousands of dollars. In 2024, already in the books, we have 2 demolitions on Meadow Street and Clarks Pike. We are going to repave Meadow Street this year through a cdbg grant. We are going to do a sewer relining from Crystal View to Ferry Street and that will almost complete that we have to do to complete the decent decree with the Sewer lines with the DEP. That will be done with a CDBG grant. Good News this board of commissioners came through in a big way, last week we were awarded a Pa Small Water and Sewer fund of \$215K grant that we have slated to use for the Marion Street Sewer Project. You guys deserve a pat on the back for bringing money into our community. I must give kudos to our Senator Lindsay Williams and State Rep Mandy Steele. We have some big things to address this year, the water rate. Tarentum has raised the rate to us again for the 6th time in two years. We want to enact an amusement tax. We have started to look at it. We will have to have meetings to decide our work schedule and set goals for 2024. I think that the Board did a wonderful job this year.
